## TUITION ASSISTANCE PROSPECTUS

### Pratt Background:

Pratt Fine Arts Center is named in honor of Mr. Edwin T. Pratt. Mr. Pratt was Executive Director of the Seattle Urban League from 1961 to 1969 and a member of the Central Area Civil Rights Organization and a leader in the struggle for integration in Seattle. He was assassinated at his Seattle home on January 26, 1969. Pratt Fine Arts Center is proud to serve as a lasting tribute to a man who devoted his life to improving the quality of life for all people.

### Pratt Mission Statement:

Pratt is an arts education and resource center dedicated to promoting creative development and artistic engagement to the local and global community.

### Tuition Assistance Description:

A limited amount of tuition assistance is available each quarter to adults and youth who otherwise cannot afford to participate in Pratt's programs. This award will give the recipient credit towards classes, workshops and or studio use. The award must be used within the specified quarter for which it was awarded.

### Eligibility:

The award is based on financial need. Applicants may be beginning, intermediate or advanced students. An individual may only receive tuition assistance twice in a lifetime.

Application: All applications must include the following information.

- A one-page typewritten proposal, summarizing the nature of your work and your goals in pursuing art. Please specify which class(es) you wish to take and what new skills or techniques you would like to learn or expand upon. Please include any information you believe is relevant to consider your financial need, such as how many people are supported by your income, and how additional expenses, debts, etc. affect your ability to pay.
- A letter in support of your application from someone in your community, family, church, etc.
- Completed Tuition Assistance application form.
- Completed registration form.
