



Seattle Print Arts Scholarship in Printmaking 2009 - 2010

Background: Thanks to the support of Seattle Print Arts, Pratt is pleased to award this annual scholarship in printmaking.

Description: One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded for use in Pratt's printmaking programs. This scholarship is for credit toward Pratt classes or workshops, studio rental. If the recipient chooses to use the scholarship for studio rental, they will be required to complete a rental test prior to using the facility. \$250.00 maximum of the award can be used toward supplies. The award should be used from September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010.

Eligibility: Eligible applicants must show a dedicated interest in and commitment to printmaking. Previous involvement with Pratt is not required. Pratt board members and their families, as well as Pratt staff are not eligible to apply. Instructors are eligible. Up to two Pratt scholarships can be awarded to any given individual during his or her lifetime. A jury of artists and arts professionals will select the recipient.

Application: All applications must include a typewritten project proposal, not to exceed one page, explaining:

- Why you wish to apply for this scholarship
- What you intend to do with the opportunity
- At the bottom of the page, one paragraph that states whether you are applying for a merit-based or financial need-based scholarship, or both. Include information to support your eligibility based on merit and financial need.

Also include:

- Up to 6 images (see guidelines) of current work, each labeled with a number and ordered as you wish to have them viewed. Also include your name and the title of each piece.
- An image list, including the title of the piece, its dimensions, medium, and the year it was produced. Please note that Pratt may use your images for promotional purposes. If applying for more than one scholarship, only one set of images is required
- A current resume or brief biography
- A completed scholarship application form
- 3 copies of entire application
- Pratt can not be responsible for the return of materials submitted

Deadline: Applications are due July 1, 2009. The scholarship recipient will be announced in August 2009. For more information please email: tfugami@pratt.org. Application packets should be addressed to:
