



# The Vascovitz Adult Scholarships in Drawing and Painting 2009 - 2010

**Scholarship Background:** This new annual scholarship for adults is made possible through generous support from the Vascovitz family.

**Award Description:** Two \$2,000 scholarships will be available for credit toward classes or workshops (including fees and membership) in Pratt's drawing and painting studios. Related coursework in career development at Pratt may also be included. A maximum of \$200 may be applied toward art supplies. The award must be used between September 1, 2009 and August 31, 2010.

**Eligibility:** This scholarship will be awarded to an emerging artist (18 years and above) working in drawing and/or painting who has been involved in Pratt Fine Arts Center. This artist must demonstrate a combination of financial need and artistic merit. Pratt board members and their families, as well as Pratt staff are not eligible to apply. Instructors are eligible. Up to two Pratt scholarship awards are given to any given individual during his or her lifetime. A jury of artists and arts professionals will select the recipient.

**Application:** All applications must include a typewritten project proposal, not to exceed one page, explaining:

- What you intend to accomplish during the scholarship year
- How your proposal relates to your previous experience
- How this scholarship could enhance your artistic development and goals
- Why financial assistance would be helpful to you in pursuing your artistic goals

Also include:

- Up to 6 images (see guidelines) of current work, each labeled with a number and ordered as you wish to have them viewed. Also include your name and the title of each piece.
- An image list, including the title of the piece, its dimensions, medium, and the year it was produced. Please note that Pratt may use your images for promotional purposes. If applying for more than one scholarship, only one set of images is required
- A current resume or brief biography
- A completed scholarship application form
- A letter of recommendation from an individual in the community who know you.
- 3 copies of entire application
- Pratt can not be responsible for the return of materials submitted
